Just a few updates from me this week:

Christmas cards

The children have been asking me this week about whether they can bring Christmas cards into school from December. Children can bring Christmas cards in (for their class only please) from Tuesday December 1st to Friday December 11th. Regardless of when children bring them in, these will be placed in a box in the classroom until Monday 14th (after being quarantined over the weekend) when they will be given out. We hope this way, children can still experience the joy of giving and receiving Christmas cards!

Reception class Lunchtimes

We've reviewed our processes and staffing for midday supervisors looking after Reception children at lunchtime to ensure that they are looked after **only** by staff within their bubble. This means that there will be less staff in the hall to help with cutting up food etc. You can support us with this by helping your children to learn to use a knife and fork at home and by ensuring that items sent in packed lunches can be easily opened by children avoiding those peskily packaged items such as capri sun drinks, cheese-strings and frubes!
