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## Greetings from Touch type/Computing club with Mrs Powell and Mrs Lee-Hamiltion!

Touch-Typing club runs for KS2 pupils throughout the school year.

**What is touch typing?** The practice or skill of typing using all one's fingers and without looking at the keys. Touch typing typically involves placing the eight fingers in a horizontal row along the middle of the keyboard (the home row a to ;) and having them reach for other keys.

Why learn to touch type? When you can do it well, touch typing is the fastest way to write. Many people quickly learn touch type faster than they can write with a pen.

The important things to remember are:

- use the correct fingers
- there's no need to rush!
- find a comfortable working position with support for your wrist and forearm.

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# PARKING AND SAFETY AROUND SCHOOL GROUNDS
