In Maths we will be learning:

- Multiplication and division- this will involve making equal groups, drawing arrays, doubling, sharing and recapping counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Number fractions- this will focus on wholes, halves and quarters.
- Geometry- looking at position and direction. The children will be describing and turns.

English

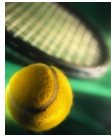

PSHCE- The children will be learning about the importance of rules and consequences of not following them; caring for the needs of babies, young children and animals; exploring our similarities and differences and an introduction to democracy.

Computing- Children will learn what data is and the different ways that it can be represented, both with and without a computer before developing their understanding of why data is useful, how it will be used and ways in which it can be gathered and recorded both by humans and computers.

Music- Children will use their bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of classical music that represent animals. They will learn and perform a song as a class and compose a short section of Music, with a focus on dynamics and tempo.

Science- This half term our topic is called 'Plants and animals'. The children will explore their local environment to find out about plants and animals that live in their locality. Children will learn to name and identify wild and common garden plants and trees
