In our text based English unit we are studying traditional tales and are focusing upon retelling and writing using story telling language. We are also working on spelling and grammar including punctuating sentences with capital letters and full stops, linking sentences using conjunctions and using expanded noun phrases. We will teaching phonics daily in the build up to the phonics screener test in the Autumn term.

Ways to support your child include: reading with your child daily and working alongside your child on their homework.

be creating repeating patterns, taking rubbings and looking to develop our pencil drawings.


PSHE: We are thinking about our wellbeing and identifying our own and other people's feelings.
