#### Maths

In maths we will be completing our unit on fractions and then will move on to measurement, focusing on length and height. We will be measuring, comparing and ordering in centimeters and meters. We will also be using the 4 operations with length as well as problem solving.

We then move on to position and direction, describing movement using vocabulary such as left, right, forwards and backwards as well as quarter and right turns.

Arithmetic will also form part of our daily maths lessons.

### **English**

In English we will be reading 'The Extraordinary adventures of Mr Benn by David Mckee.

We will be focusing upon how these stories are structured and will be analyzing the language used. We will then use this as a model for planning and writing our own individual Mr Benn story.

We will continue to complete reading, spelling and handwriting activities daily. Please ensure reading books are brought in daily.
