Maths

In maths we will be continuing our topic on statistics. In this we will be drawing and interpreting pictograms and block diagrams. We then move onto recognizing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. This will include developing our understanding of sides, vertices, faces etc. as well as learning about patterns and symmetry. We then hope to move onto learning about fractions; in particular halves, quarters and thirds of shapes and numbers. Initially all work will be available on Google Classrooms so you could look on here to support your child further at home

English

In English we will be learning how to read and write explanation texts linked to Pie Corbett's Teacher Pleaser and Wallace and Gromit's Cracking Contraptions. We will continue to explore different sentence openers and technical vocabulary as well as the use of a wide range of punctuation. Reading comprehension activities will form an important part of our weekly lessons and spellings and handwriting will continue to be taught daily. We will also continue to develop our understanding of the Y2 grammar concepts focusing on different word and sentence types.
