In Maths, we will be focusing on:


Addition and Subtraction of ones, tens and hundreds using single digit, two digit and three digit numbers.

Reading Schemes and Books

In Year 3, children continue to use the PM books scheme that they used in Year 2.

In order to change reading books, due to the new measures in school, we ask for them to be brought in every FRIDAY and they will get a new reading book every MONDAY. They need to record their reading in their new reading records and bring them in WITH their reading books. There is also space at the bottom of the page to record any tricky words. If they do not finish their book in time for Friday, keep it until it has been completed and they will get a new one on the next Monday after they have returned it.

Throughout the week it would be great if your child can read the book more than once. This will really help with fluency and practice any tricky words they found as they read it the first time through.

I've been réading with each child over the last two weeks and there are a few things that they can be working on at home

- ⇒ Slow reading speed down, taking note of punctuation
- ⇒ Tracking the sentence with a finger to avoid missing lines out
- ⇒ Re-reading a sentence if it didn't make sense
- ⇒ Asking for help with any words they don't understand the meaning of








Homework
