Reading Schemes and Books

In Year 4 we use a reading scheme called Accelerated Reader, this scheme generates an individualised reading range for each child. Each child is given the freedom to choose their own reading book that is within their reading range.

Once children have read the whole of their book they need to complete the accelerated reading quiz at home 24-48 hours after they have finished reading it. Children have been given accelerated reading diaries where they need to record the title of their book and the number of pages they have read each day along with the percentage they scored after each quiz. After the quiz the scheme will log each child's percentage score and appropriately adapt their reading range. Children only need to quiz once on each book, after they have completed the quiz they will be given a new book to read.

The children have their accelerated reader log in details in their reading diaries. Below is the link to accelerated reader:


